A minor complaint but I just didn't know the world as well as I'd have liked. There is more narrative and descriptive prose than dialogue and in places it felt rather like an old Viking saga, with shades of the Sorcerer's Apprentice running through it. With the convenience and economy of being able to buy this in Kindle format it seemed the perfect time to take the time to re-explore this series, and I do not have to dig through a box of books, under the stairs in a country far, far away to get my hands on my old hard copy, which helps as.
